Studio Policies

Lesson Preparation

It is highly valuable to practice outside of lessons. I have seen most success with 30 minutes of daily practice at least 5 days a week. These 30 minutes don't have to be one session all at once, but can be spread out during the day to focus on retaining technique. I record the audio of all lessons and upload them to a folder on my website accessible only to you. Listening to and singing along with these recordings daily can be a good way to make sure you're staying on task while practicing.

Please come to lessons with any questions that you ran into during the week. You will progress quickly if you are consistently evaluating both your short and long term vocal goals. I do my best to check in on what you are working towards, so it is best that we are both on the same page when it comes to your goals and questions.

I am happy to suggest and assign songs for you to work on. You are also welcome to choose repertoire yourself in whatever style you are focusing on. Please come to lessons already knowing at least the basics of whatever song you want to work on. Learning notes and rhythms isn't the most effective use of time in a technique lesson.

You are welcome to bring your own accompanist. If you choose not to, we will use minus tracks and other recordings.

Each lesson is spent on both vocal technique, and applying that technique to music. There is no set lesson plan for any individual lesson, but they are tailored to what I believe will help you succeed the most based on how you are that day.

Payment

Lessons are expected to be paid for before or at the time each lesson is given. I accept cash, PayPal, Venmo, and personal check. Cancellations must be given with 24 hours' notice, or payment will still be required. Last minute cancellations due to sickness or family emergency will be considered on a case by case basis. If you think you will be too sick to come to a lesson, please cancel.

Teacher cancelled lessons will not be charged, and will be given priority in rescheduling.

Please arrive to lessons on time. When booking a lesson, you are reserving the 30/60-minute block of time that you schedule. If you arrive 15 minutes late to a 30-minute lesson, your lesson will not be 30 minutes long. If you are going to be late to a lesson, text or call me.

Monthly payment reserves your slot weekly. A cancelled lesson with monthly payment must be rescheduled within 30 days of the original lesson date. Some months have 5 lessons, some have 4. I highly suggest paying monthly.

Cost

30-minute lesson: \$30 per lesson or \$120 per month

60-minute lesson: \$60 per lesson or \$240 per month

Group lessons add \$10 per person per half hour. A 2 person 30-minute lesson would be \$40, 3 people would be \$50, etc. Group lessons are generally not as effective as 1 on 1 lessons.

Parents are welcome to observe lessons. Parent observation is encouraged for students under the age of 12.
